TOWN OF BISHOP'S FALLS DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS AMENDMENT No. 4, 2018

BACKGROUND

Amendment No. 4 to the Bishop's Falls Development Regulations is proposed in order to give Council more control over types of development in the Town Centre (TC), General Commercial (GC), Civic-Institutional (CVI), and Recreational Open Space (ROS) zones. Wherever the following classifications are listed in the Permitted Use Classes of those zones, they will be transferred to the Discretionary Use Classes.

- Amusement Use
- Assembly
- Club and Lodge
- Cultural Use
- Entertainment Use

PUBLIC CONSULTATION

Council provided public notice of the proposed amendment by advertisement in the Central Voice newspaper on September 19, 2018. The notice asked that written comments or objections be submitted to Council on or before October 4, 2018. No comments were received as of the deadline.

DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS AMENDMENT No. 4, 2018

The Bishop's Falls Development Regulations are amended as follows:

- I. Schedule C Town Centre Use Zone Table
 - Transfer the "Amusement Use", "Assembly", "Club and Lodge", "Cultural Use" and "Entertainment Use" classifications from the Permitted Use Classes to the Discretionary Use Classes.
- 2. Schedule C General Commercial Use Zone Table
 - Transfer the "Assembly", "Club and Lodge", and "Cultural Use" classifications from the Permitted Use Classes to the Discretionary Use Classes.
- 3. Schedule C Civic-Institutional Use Zone Table
 - Transfer the "Assembly", and "Entertainment" classifications from the Permitted Use Classes to the Discretionary Use Classes.
